1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

CONCEPT DRAFT SUMMARY

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4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill proposes to streamline the licensure procedure for sign language 6 interpreters. Specifically, this bill would amend the laws regarding educational 7 requirements for license renewals for sign language interpreters and would address 8 conflicts between those statutory requirements and the practice by schools of hiring 9 unlicensed interpreters to work with students.
