1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Main
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Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1766-A is enacted to read:

§1766-A. Electricity purchases for state buildings

- No later than January 1, 2010, all electricity consumed in state-owned or state-leased buildings must be supplied by renewable resources. For purposes of this section, "renewable resource" means any renewable resource defined in Title 35-A, section 3210, subsection 2, paragraph C.
- 8 Sec. 2. Plan to implement electricity purchases for state buildings. The chair of the Energy Resources Council, established in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5,
- section 3327, shall develop a plan to implement Title 5, section 1766-A and shall submit
- that plan including suggested legislation to the Joint Standing Committee on Utilities and Energy and the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government by April 1,
- 13 2008. The Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government is authorized to
- introduce legislation related to the plan.

15 SUMMARY

- This bill requires that by January 1, 2010 all electricity consumed in state-owned or state-leased buildings be supplied by renewable resources. It requires the chair of the Energy Resources Council to develop a plan to achieve this requirement and to submit
- that plan to the Joint Standing Committee on Utilities and Energy and the Joint Standing
- 20 Committee on State and Local Government by April 1, 2008.
