4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill proposes to promote economic growth in the St. John Valley. Specifically,
6 the bill would authorize Aroostook County to send out to the voters a bond issue for
7 economic development. The bond amount is to be determined by Aroostook County
8 Commissioners.
