1 Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 3 Whereas, motor fuel prices have risen dramatically over the past year; and 4 Whereas, meals on wheels programs rely on volunteer drivers to deliver food to participants; and 5 Whereas, it is necessary to reimburse the volunteer drivers for mileage to ensure the 6 continued viability of the meals on wheels programs; and 7 8 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as 10 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore. 11 12 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and 13 14 allocations are made. 15 HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF 16 Elder and Adult Services, Bureau of 17 Initiative: Provides funds to reimburse volunteers for meals on wheels programs for increased travel expenses resulting from increased motor fuel costs. 18 19 20 GENERAL FUND 2007-08 2008-09 21 \$75,000 \$75,000 All Other 22 23 \$75,000 \$75,000 GENERAL FUND TOTAL 24 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved. 25 **SUMMARY** 26 This bill appropriates funds to reimburse volunteers for meals on wheels programs 27

for increased travel expenses resulting from increased motor fuel costs.
