	15	Amend the bill striking out all of section 3.
	16	SUMMARY
	17	This amendment requires that 100% instead of 25% of gross proceeds received from
	18	entry fees for a bass tournament involving Special Olympics Maine be donated to Special
	19	Olympics Maine or be awarded to participants as prizes.
