11 Amend the amendment by striking out the substitute title and replacing it with the
12 following:

13 **'Resolve, Directing the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Liquor**
14 **Licensing and Compliance To Study the Retail Placement and Marketing of**
15 **Spirits, Beer and Wine with Regard to Minors'**

16 Amend the amendment in section 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 19 in amendment) by
17 inserting after the following: "spirits" the following: ', beer and wine'

18 Amend the amendment in section 1 in the 4th line (page 1, line 21 in amendment) by
19 inserting after the following: "spirits" the following: ', beer and wine

20 Amend the amendment in section 1 in the 5th line (page 1, line 22 in amendment) by
21 inserting after the following: "spirits" the following: ', beer and wine

22 Amend the amendment in section 1 in the 6th line (page 1, line 23 in amendment) by
23 inserting after the following: "spirits" the following: ', beer and wine

25 This amendment directs the bureau of liquor licensing and compliance within the
26 Department of Public Safety to include beer and wine in its study regarding the retail
27 placement and advertising of spirits with regard to minors.
