Fiscal Detail and Notes

Allowing the Maine State Retirement System to transfer contributions of a member who has been inactive for at least 10 years and whose member contributions, not including accumulated interest, are less than \$100 to the Retirement Allowance Fund is expected to increase the Fund by approximately \$732,000 in fiscal year 2007-08. According the the Maine State Retirement System, there are approximately 28,000 inactive members with average contributions of \$26 per member.
