1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and
3 allocations are made.

4 **COMMUNITY COLLEGE SYSTEM, BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE MAINE**

5 **Maine Community College System - Board of Trustees**

6 Initiative: Provides funding for a new position at Central Maine Community College to
7 employ a full-time counselor and administrator to coordinate course delivery; to work
8 with school districts, applied technology centers and adult education centers to establish
9 courses and recruit and advise students; and to meet with local businesses to meet specific
10 training needs. The funding would also provide for transportation costs, advertising and
11 clerical support.

17 **SUMMARY**

18 This bill makes ongoing General Fund appropriations of \$150,000 per year to fund a
19 full-time counselor and administrator position at Central Maine Community College to
20 work to increase the student population at the college and to fund transportation costs,
21 advertising and clerical support.
