11	Amend the amendment in section 1 in the 4th line (page 1, line 19 in amendment) by
12	striking out the following: "let." and inserting the following: 'let -; such private homes
13	must post in a visible location in each rented room a card with the following statement in
14	text that is easily readable in no less than 18-point boldface type of uniform font "This
15 .	lodging place is not regulated by the State of Maine Department of Health and Human
16	Services, Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention." The homes must provide
17	guests upon check-in with a notice containing the same information.'
18	SUMMARY
19	This amendment specifies that private homes that are not considered lodging places
20	and are not subject to licensing must post in a visible location in each rented room a card
21	informing the public that the lodging place is not regulated by the Department of Health
22	and Human Services, Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention, and must provide
23	guests upon check-in with a notice containing the same information.
