1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 9-A MRSA §8-303, sub-§8 is enacted to read:

3 8. A card issuer may not refuse to accept or charge a fee for more than one payment
4 on a credit card debt by a cardholder within a one-month period.

SUMMARY

6 This bill prohibits a credit card issuer from refusing to accept or charging a fee for 7 more than one payment on a credit card debt by a cardholder within a one-month period.
