### COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 325, L.D. 1008

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#### **SUMMARY**

This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment creates a resolve that directs the executive director of the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices to provide historical data regarding complaints received about legislative ethics violations during the past 10 years. The resolve requires the report to be submitted to the Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs by February 15, 2008.
