- **Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1272,** as amended by PL 1995, c. 134, §1 and as repealed by c. 462, Pt. A, §21 and affected by §23, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:
- A state agency, as defined in Title 3, section 992, subsection 6, may not use a social security number for the sole purpose of identifying a person in order to provide services to that person or to take enforcement action against that person.
