1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §12723** is enacted to read:

3 **§12723. Tuition waiver for low-income residents**

4 A person who has a gross family income of less than \$50,000 a year may attend any
5 institution within the system free from tuition charges.

6 **SUMMARY**

7 This bill allows a person who has a gross family income of less than \$50,000 a year
8 to attend any institution within the Maine Community College System free from tuition
9 charges.
