1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. Transfer of funds.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, on or
3 before October 1, 2007, the State Controller shall transfer \$27,300 from the
4 unappropriated surplus of the General Fund to the Maine Coast Environmental Trust
5 Fund account as established pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section
6 6136.

7 **Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and
8 allocations are made.

10 **Maine Coast Environmental Trust Fund**
