1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §4730** is enacted to read:

3 **§4730. Completion of college application**

4 In addition to the requirements of this chapter and the system of learning results  
5 established in section 6209, in order to receive a diploma, a secondary school student  
6 must complete at least one application to a college, university or other postsecondary  
7 educational institution.

8 **SUMMARY**

9 This bill requires secondary school students to complete at least one application to a  
10 postsecondary educational institution.
