15 'Sec. 1. Review of limited English proficiency cost component. Resolved: That, notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15686-A, 16 subsection 2, the Commissioner of Education shall conduct a fiscal and program review 17 of the costs reported by school administrative units that receive a portion of their total 18 19 operating allocation for limited English proficiency students. The purpose of this review is to develop clear and transparent procedures for collecting and reporting valid and 20 21 reliable data on the costs of providing services to limited English proficiency students through programs approved by the Department of Education pursuant to Title 20-A, 22 23 section 15675, subsection 1. Funding for this review must be included in the contract for updating essential programs and services components pursuant to Title 20-A, section 24 25 15689-A, subsection 3; and be it further

26 Sec. 2. That, no later than January 31, 2009, the **Report.** Resolved: 27 Commissioner of Education shall submit a report that includes findings and 28 recommendations pursuant to section 1, including any necessary suggested legislation to 29 implement clear and transparent procedures for collecting and reporting valid and reliable data on the costs of providing services to limited English proficiency students, for 30 31 presentation to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over 32 education and cultural affairs.'

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SUMMARY

This amendment is one of the minority reports of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs. The amendment strikes and replaces the concept draft to require the Commissioner of Education to conduct a fiscal and program review of the costs reported by school administrative units that receive a portion of their total operating allocation for limited English proficiency students. The commissioner shall report the findings and recommendations from the review to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education and cultural affairs by January 31, 2009.
