This amendment replaces the bill and is the majority report of the committee. The amendment changes the bill from an act to a resolve. The amendment requires the Legislature to contract for an update to a 2002 study of the feasibility of establishing a single-payor health plan in the State. The amendment requires that the updated study be submitted to the First Regular Session of the 124th Legislature and authorizes the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health insurance matters to submit legislation based on the updated feasibility study.

The Legislature is required to seek an outside grant to fund updating a 2002 study. The bill includes a General Fund appropriation to the Legislature of \$5,750 in fiscal year 2008-09 to contract out for professional services for grant writing and technical assistance. The bill also includes an Other Special Revenue Funds allocation to the Legislature of \$235,100 in fiscal year 2008-09 to permit expenditure of an outside grant.
