- 7 Amend the resolve by striking out all of sections 8, 9 and 10 and inserting the 8 following:
- 9 'Sec. 8. Report. Resolved: That, no later than December 5, 2007, the 10 commission shall submit a report that includes its findings and recommendations, including any suggested legislation, for presentation to the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry. The Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, 12 13 Conservation and Forestry is authorized to introduce legislation related to the harness racing industry to the Second Regular Session of the 123rd Legislature; and be it further 14
- 15 Sec. 9. Commission budget. Resolved: That the commission shall seek outside funds to fully fund all costs of the commission. If sufficient outside funding has not been 16 received by the commission by September 15, 2007 to fully fund all costs of the 17 commission, no meetings are authorized and no expenses of any kind may be incurred or 18 reimbursed. Contributions to support the work of the commission may not be accepted 19 20 from any party having a pecuniary or other vested interest in the outcome of the matters 21 being studied. Any person, other than a state agency, desiring to make a financial or inkind contribution must certify to the Legislative Council that it has no pecuniary or other 22 23 vested interest in the outcome of the study. The certification must be made in the manner prescribed by the Legislative Council. All contributions are subject to approval by the 24 25 Legislative Council. All funds accepted must be forwarded to the Executive Director of the Legislative Council along with an accounting record that includes the amount of the 26 27 funds, the date the funds were received, from whom the funds were received and the purpose of and any limitation on the use of the funds. The Executive Director of the 28 Legislative Council shall administer any funds received by the commission. 29 executive director shall notify the chairs of the commission when sufficient funding has 30 been received. Within 10 days after its first meeting, the commission shall present a 31 work plan and proposed budget to the Legislative Council for its approval. The 32 33 commission may not incur expenses that would result in the commission's exceeding its approved budget; and be it further 34
