COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 802, L.D. 1084, Bill, "An Act To Provide Adult Adoptees Access to Their Original Birth Certificates"

Amend the bill in section 5 in §2769 in subsection 3 in paragraph C in the first line (page 3, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "I would prefer not to be contacted." and inserting the following: 'Do not contact me.'

This amendment revises one of the choices that a birth parent can indicate on the contact preference form to "Do not contact me."

The Department of Health and Human Services would incur additional costs in implementing this bill for the January 1, 2009 effective date. The bill authorizes the department to increase fees that would help offset these additional costs.
