SENATE AMENDMENT "*A*" to H.P. 802, L.D. 1084, Bill, "An Act To Provide Adult Adoptees Access to Their Original Birth Certificates"

Amend the bill in section 4 in §2768 in subsection 1 in the first line (page 1, line 38 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "18" and inserting the following: '21'
