1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§7-B,** as enacted by PL 2005, c. 12, Pt. GGG, §2,
3 is amended to read:

4 **7-B. Products used in commercial agricultural crop production.** Sales of water,
5 seed, fertilizers, defoliant and pesticides, including, but not limited to, rodenticides,
6 insecticides, fungicides and weed killers, for use in the commercial production of an
7 agricultural crop.

8 **Sec. 2. Effective date.** This Act takes effect October 1, 2007.

9 **SUMMARY**

10 This bill adds water to the current sales tax exemption for products used in
11 commercial agricultural crop production.
