1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §2526, sub-§8, ¶A**, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 737, Pt. A, §2
3 and Pt. C, §106 and amended by PL 1989, c. 6; c. 9, §2; and c. 104, Pt. C, §§8 and 10, is
4 further amended to read:

5 A. The same person may not serve as treasurer and tax collector of a municipality.

6 **SUMMARY**

7 This bill provides that a person may not serve simultaneously as tax collector and
8 treasurer of a municipality.
