An Act To Create an Ownership Interest in Agency Liquor Store Licenses

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §453-B**, as repealed and replaced by PL 2001, c. 358, Pt. V,
3 §2, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

4 **§453-B. License fees**

5 The initial license fee for an agency liquor store and the fee for a transferee of a
6 license for an agency liquor store under section 457 is \$2,000. The renewal fee for an
7 annual license is \$300.

8 **Sec. 2. 28-A MRSA §457**, as amended by PL 1997, c. 373, §49, is repealed and
9 the following enacted in its place:

10 **§457. Transfer of agency liquor store license**

11 Upon application of a licensee under this chapter, an agency liquor store license must
12 be transferred to a new owner upon the sale of the licensed establishment and payment of
13 the transfer fee required in section 453-B if the new owner is eligible under section 601
14 and the physical premises of the establishment remain unchanged.

15 **Sec. 3. Rules.** No later than March 1, 2008, the Department of Public Safety shall
16 adopt routine technical rules pursuant to Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A to carry out
17 the purposes of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 28-A, section 457.

18 **SUMMARY**

19 This bill allows the transfer of an agency liquor store license if the new owner meets
20 the eligibility qualifications for agency liquor store owners. The bill also sets the license
21 fee for the new owner at \$2,000.
