1 L.D. 1136 Date: 5/29/07 (Filing No. H-336) 2 LEGAL AND VETERANS AFFAIRS 3 4 Reproduced and distributed under the direction of the Clerk of the House. 5 STATE OF MAINE 6 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 7 123RD LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION 8 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 829, L.D. 1136, Bill, "An Act To 9 Amend the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices' Appointment 10 11 Process" 12 Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph F by striking out all of the 4th sentence 13 (page 1, lines 12 to 15 in L.D.) and inserting the following: 'If the list of 3 qualified 14 candidates required by this paragraph to be presented to the Governor by the leaders of 15 each party from each body of the Legislature is not produced within 60 days after the vacancy is created, then the leaders of each party from both bodies of the Legislature 16 17 shall present within the subsequent 15 days a separate list of 3 qualified candidates to the 18 Governor, who shall appoint a candidate from these lists within 30 days of receiving the 19 lists.' 20 Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph G by striking out all of the 4th sentence 21 (page 1, lines 29 to 31 in L.D.) and inserting the following: 'If the list of 3 qualified 22 candidates required by this paragraph to be presented to the Governor by the leaders of 23 each party from each body of the Legislature is not produced within 60 days after the 24 vacancy is created, then the leaders of each party from both bodies of the Legislature 25 shall present within the subsequent 15 days a separate list of 3 qualified candidates to the Governor, who shall appoint a candidate from these lists within 30 days of receiving the 26 27 lists.' 28 **SUMMARY** 29 This amendment replaces the proposal made by the bill that would have required the Governor to appoint a candidate to fill a vacancy for the 5th member of the Commission 30 31 on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices if the leaders of each party from both 32 bodies of the Legislature fail to provide a jointly derived list of 3 qualified candidates 33 within 60 days of the vacancy's being created. The amendment provides that if the jointly 34 derived list is not presented to the Governor within 60 days of the vacancy's being 35 created, then within the subsequent 15 days each party from both bodies of the 36 Legislature shall present a separate list to the Governor, who shall appoint a candidate 37 within 30 days of receiving the lists.
