1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §6104, sub-§12** is enacted to read:

3 **12. Exemption.** An increase or decrease of any rate, toll or charge for a service
4 other than the provision of water that will not increase the revenues of a consumer-owned
5 water utility by more than 1% is exempt from the provisions of this section.

6 **SUMMARY**

7 This bill exempts the increase or decrease of any rate, toll or charge for a service
8 other than the provision of water that will not increase the revenues of a consumer-owned
9 water utility by more than 1% from the laws requiring that rate changes of consumer-
10 owned water utilities be subject to suspension, investigation, hearing or rate substitution
11 by the Public Utilities Commission.
