1 **Sec. 1. Department of Transportation to study Town of Naples**
2 **waterfront. Resolved:** That the Department of Transportation, with the cooperation
3 of the Department of Environmental Protection, shall study the area between Route 302
4 and Long Lake on the waterfront in the Town of Naples. The study must include a
5 review of the environmental and engineering issues surrounding the disrepair of the
6 waterfront including damaged riprap and asphalt and the feasibility replacing the
7 retaining wall between Long Lake and Route 302; and be it further

8 **Sec. 2. Report. Resolved:** That, no later than December 5, 2007, the Department
9 of Transportation shall report its findings along with any recommended legislation related
10 to the report to the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation. The Joint Standing
11 Committee on Transportation may submit a bill related to the report to the Second
12 Regular Session of the 123rd Legislature.

SUMMARY

14 This resolve directs the Department of Transportation, in cooperation with the
15 Department of Environmental Protection, to study the state of disrepair of the Town of
16 Naples waterfront and review the environmental and engineering issues surrounding the
17 disrepair of the waterfront including damaged riprap and asphalt and the feasibility of
18 replacing the retaining wall between Long Lake and Route 302.
