10 11 12 13 14	This bill prohibits Medicaid drug formulary decisions from being based solely on the amount of the anticipated prescription drug rebate or financial benefits that the State would receive as a result of adding or deleting the drug to the list of drugs subject to reimbursement and coverage under the MaineCare program. It also repeals the restrictions on delivery sales and illegal delivery of tobacco products in the State.

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
