1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **CONCEPT DRAFT**
3 **SUMMARY**

4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 The purpose of this bill is to establish another type of access to highways that the
6 Commissioner of Transportation may allow in addition to access for the development of
7 state and state aid highways. The bill would authorize the Commissioner of
8 Transportation to allow access to highways for traffic safety and rest areas, such as
9 fueling, food service and rest stops for passenger and commercial motor vehicles, located
10 within or through an area for which the department had purchased access rights.
