1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **SUMMARY**

4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill proposes to direct the Department of Health and Human Services to adopt
6 rules to license housing programs for weekly tenancies by October 1, 2007. The rules,
7 which must be designated as routine technical rules, must provide for weekly payment of
8 rent and appropriate procedures for the landlord or tenant to give notice to terminate the
9 tenancy.
