21 22 23 24 25	This amendment changes the provision in the bill that would prohibit the sale of liquor below cost. The provision now would apply only to malt liquor and wine sold for consumption off-premises. The amendment specifies that a licensee may not sell malt liquor or wine at a retail price that is less than the cost to the licensee to purchase that malt liquor or wine from a wholesaler.
