An Act To Prevent Retailers from Selling Liquor below Cost

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §2089 is enacted to read:
3	§2089. Sale of liquor below cost prohibited
4	An agency liquor store or any other retailer may not sell liquor at retail sale for less
5	than the cost of that liquor to that agency liquor store or retailer. A person who violate
6	this section commits a civil violation for which a fine of not more than \$500 may be
7	adjudged.
8	SUMMARY
9	This bill prohibits an agency liquor store or any other retailer from selling liquor a
0	retail sale for less than the cost of that liquor to that agency liquor store or retailer. The
1	bill provides that a violation of this provision is a civil violation for which a fine of no
2	more than \$500 may be adjudged.
