11	Amend the bill in section 1 in §1313 in subsection 1 in paragraph C in the first line
12	(page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "otherwise" and inserting the
13	following: 'may have otherwise'
14	Amend the bill in section 2 in §1313-A by striking out all of the first paragraph (page
15	2, lines 1 to 15 in L.D.) and inserting the following:
16	'If an undomesticated animal or a wolf hybrid suspected of having rabies bites or
17	may have otherwise exposes exposed to rabies a person or a domestic animal, an animal
18	control officer, a local health officer or a game warden must shall immediately either
19	remove the undomesticated animal or wolf hybrid or cause the undomesticated animal or

22 animal, an animal control officer, a local health officer or a law enforcement officer shall 23 immediately cause the animal to be euthanized for testing. When in the judgment of the 24 animal control officer, local health officer, game warden or law enforcement officer the 25 animal poses an immediate threat to a person or domestic animal, the animal control 26 officer, local health officer, game warden or law enforcement officer may immediately 27 kill or order killed that animal without destroying the head. The Department of Inland 28 Fisheries and Wildlife shall arrange for the transportation of the head to the State Health 29 and Environmental Testing Laboratory; except that the animal control officer shall make 30 the arrangements if the animal is a wolf hybrid.'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the provisions for removing or euthanizing an undomesticated animal or wolf hybrid suspected of having rabies apply when the animal has bitten someone or the animal may have otherwise exposed a person or domestic animal to rabies.
