"Automobile mechanic" means a person who is Automobile mechanic. primarily engaged in the servicing of automobiles or trucks as an employee of an 15 establishment primarily engaged in the business of selling automobiles or trucks to the 16 ultimate purchaser, as long as the person's annual compensation exceeds 3,000 times the 17 18 state minimum hourly wage or the annualized rate\_established by the United States Department of Labor under the federal Fair Labor Standards Act, whichever is higher, 19 20 except when the employee is paid by the employer on an hourly basis. 21 Sec. 3. 26 MRSA §663, sub-§13, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 507, §1, is amended 22 to read: 23 13. Automobile parts clerk. "Automobile parts clerk" means a person employed for the purpose of and primarily engaged in requisitioning, stocking and dispensing 24 25 automobile parts as an employee of an establishment primarily engaged in the business of 26 selling automobiles or trucks to the ultimate purchaser, as long as the person's annual 27 compensation exceeds 3,000 times the state minimum hourly wage or the annualized rate 28 established by the United States Department of Labor under the federal Fair Labor 29 Standards Act, whichever is higher, except when the employee is paid by the employer on 30 an hourly basis.' 31 Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 14 in the 5th line (page 1, line 14, in L.D.) 32 by inserting after the following: "purchaser," the following: 'as long as the person's 33 annual compensation exceeds 3,000 times the state minimum hourly wage or the annualized rate established by the United States Department of Labor under the federal 34 35 Fair Labor Standards Act, whichever is higher,'

### COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 913, L.D. 1295

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1 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or 2 section number to read consecutively.

#### **SUMMARY**

4 This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Labor. It 5 adds the qualifying language that a person's annual compensation must exceed 3,000 6 times the state minimum hourly wage to the definitions of "automobile mechanic," 7 "automobile parts clerk" and "automobile service writer."
