1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1955** is enacted to read:

3 **§1955. Construction vehicle**

4 A construction vehicle must be equipped with a backup sensor. For the purposes of
5 this section, “backup sensor” means a device on a vehicle that makes a sound when the
6 vehicle is in reverse.

7 **SUMMARY**

8 This bill requires a construction vehicle to be equipped with a backup sensor.
