Resolve, To Create a New Hunter Safety Course

safety course. Resolved: That, by January 1, 2008, the Department of Inland
Fisheries and Wildlife shall design and implement a hunter safety course that includes:

4 1. An option for home study or classroom instruction;

5 2. One day at a shooting range for a written examination and for using a firearm; and

- 6 3. Options for firearm, bow and crossbow hunting instruction in a single course.
 - SUMMARY

8 This bill directs the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to create a new 9 hunter safety course that includes an option for home study or classroom instruction, a 10 day at the shooting range and options for firearm, bow and crossbow hunting instruction.
