1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §707-B** is enacted to read:

3 **§707-B. Exceptions to indebtedness or operations limitations for farm wineries**

4 Notwithstanding section 707, a person that owns or has a financial interest in a holder
5 of a retail license issued in conjunction with and as part of the operations of a farm
6 winery may own or have a financial interest in a retail license.

7 **SUMMARY**

8 This bill allows a person who owns a farm winery to be granted a retail wine license.
