1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §19-C** is enacted to read:

3 **§19-C. Political activities of constitutional officers**

4 The Secretary of State, Treasurer of State and Attorney General may not endorse a
5 candidate for the Legislature.

6 **SUMMARY**

7 This bill prohibits the Secretary of State, Treasurer of State and Attorney General
8 from endorsing a candidate for the Legislature.
