1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 CONCEPT DRAFT 3 SUMMARY

4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill proposes to preserve the provisions of the Essential Programs and Services 6 Funding Act that determine each school administrative unit's total allocation, but to discontinue the method of determining the local share and the state share of the total 7 allocation by means of the maximum mill rate expectation system. The bill would restore 8 9 the structure of the school subsidy distribution system that was discontinued in fiscal year 2005-06. Prior to fiscal year 2005-06, the school funding formula utilized a combination 10 of relative local property valuation, weighted at 85%, and relative local median income, 11 weighted at 15%, to determine the local share of the total allocation. 12
