1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §508 is enacted to read:
3	§508. Costs for defending appeal
4 5 6 7 8	If a court upholds a municipality's assessment under this chapter and the property owner challenges an assessment on the same property for a different tax year, the property owner must pay the reasonable costs and attorney's fees of the municipality in defending the subsequent challenge if the municipality prevails on the subsequent challenge.
9	SUMMARY
10 11 12	This bill requires a property owner to pay the reasonable costs and attorney's fees of a successful defense to an appeal of a property assessment if the municipality's assessment on the property for a different year had been previously upheld by a court.
