Secretary of State to create emergency notification program. 2 Resolved: That the Secretary of State shall create a program to allow a person upon 3 application or renewal of the person's driver's license to provide emergency notification 4 information for the Secretary of State or a law enforcement agency in the event of an 5 accident or emergency. The information provided may include the name and contact 6 information of a family member, employer, health provider or other person or vital health 7 information concerning the person; and be it further

8 Sec. 2. Rules. Resolved: That the Secretary of State may adopt routine technical 9 rules pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A to 10 carry out the purposes of section 1.

SUMMARY

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12 This bill directs the Secretary of State to create a program in which a person applying

13 for or receiving their driver's license can provide emergency contact information in case 14 of an accident or emergency.
