An Act To Amend the Maine Tort Claims Act

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §8105, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1999, c. 460, §1 and as affected by §2, is further amended to read:
- 1. Limit established. In any claim or cause of action permitted by this chapter, the award of damages, including costs, against either a governmental entity or its employees, or both, may not exceed \$400,000 \$1,000,000 for any and all claims arising out of a single occurrence.
- **Sec. 2. Retroactivity.** This Act applies retroactively to October 10, 2006.

9 SUMMARY

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This bill raises the limitation on damages under the Maine Tort Claims Act from \$400,000 to \$1,000,000.
