Resolved: That in order to increase the number of physicians who are practicing specialized medicine in Maine, the 2 3 Department of Health and Human Services shall establish a program by rule to facilitate the process by which general care physicians further their education. In establishing the 4 5 program, the department shall work with the Board of Licensure in Medicine to evaluate 6 the needs of this program and the department shall consult with appropriate federal 7 agencies to assist in establishment of financial aid packages for this program. Rules 8 established pursuant to this resolve are routine technical rules as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A. 9
