1 4%. The Consumer Price Index adjustment for September 2006 was 4.3%. This bill
2 authorizes the Board of Trustees of the Maine State Retirement System to implement a
3 one-time additional increase of .30% for retirees of participating local districts who were
4 eligible for a cost-of-living adjustment in September 2006. The additional .30% increase
5 will be paid retroactively to September 2006.
