17 18 19	Amend the amendment in section 7 in §317-A in the first paragraph in the first line (page 2, line 28 in amendment) by striking out the following: " $$2,000$ " and inserting the following: ' $$5,000$ '
20	SUMMARY
21 22 23 24	This amendment clarifies the definition of "grassroots lobbying" to specify that it includes an advertisement or other paid programming transmitted through a broadcast or cable station or satellite transmission and a paid advertisement in a newspaper or other print media.
25 26	This amendment also increases the grassroots lobbying spending threshold at which a person is required to file a report from \$2,000 to \$5,000.
