5 the Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Response Services who
6 participate in a standby rotation on January 1, 2002 or are hired thereafter; ~~and~~

7 **Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §17851-A, sub-§1, ¶M**, as enacted by PL 2001, c. 646, §2, is
8 amended to read:

9 M. Capital security officers in the employment of the Department of Public Safety,
10 Bureau of Capital Security on July 1, 2002 or hired thereafter; ~~and~~

11 **Sec. 3. 5 MRSA §17851-A, sub-§1, ¶N** is enacted to read:

12 N. Children's services caseworkers, including child protective workers, supervisors
13 and program administrators, in the employment of the Department of Health and
14 Human Services on July 1, 2007 or are hired thereafter.

15 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill includes children's services caseworkers, supervisors and program
17 administrators working in the Department of Health and Human Services on or hired by
18 the department after July 1, 2007 in the 1998 Special Plan under the Maine State
19 Retirement System. The plan's option to retire at age 55 recognizes the daily dangerous
20 and stressful situations these staff face in their positions.
