COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 992, L.D. 1409, Bill, "An Act To Make Technical Changes to Maine's Aquaculture Statutes"

Amend the bill by striking out section 3 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §6073, sub-§2-B is enacted to read:

2-B. Marking. In the coastal waters of the State, a person may not mark or designate an area as a sea farm, aquaculture lease or other similar designation unless that area is currently leased for aquaculture or is under consideration by the department for a lease through the aquaculture lease application process.'

SUMMARY

This amendment makes a technical change to reallocate a section of the bill to a more appropriate place in statute.
