11	Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following:

12 'Resolve, Regarding Tobacco Cessation and Treatment'

Amend the resolve by striking out everything after the title and before the summary 13 and inserting the following: 14

15 'Sec. 1. Best practice and model treatment programs. Resolved: That the Department of Health and Human Services, through the Partnership for a Tobacco-Free 16 Maine, Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention and the Office of MaineCare 17 Services, shall undertake a study of best practice treatment and clinical practice 18 19 guidelines for tobacco cessation treatment. The study must use the most recent available clinical practice guidelines available from the United States Department of Health and 20 Human Services Public Health Service and must include development of a model tobacco 21 22 cessation treatment program for use in the public sector and private sector. The department shall report back to the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human 23 Services by January 15, 2008. The committee may submit legislation to the Second 24 25 Regular Session of the 123rd Legislature related to best practice treatment and clinical 26 practice guidelines for tobacco cessation treatment.'

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SUMMARY

28 This amendment replaces the resolve and substitutes a new title. The amendment directs the Department of Health and Human Services, through the Partnership for a 29 Tobacco-Free Maine, Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention and the Office of 30 MaineCare Services, to undertake a study of best practice treatment and clinical practice 31 32 guidelines for tobacco cessation treatment. The amendment requires the department to report to the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services by January 15, 33 2008 and authorizes the committee to submit legislation. 34
