4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5	This bill proposes to adopt a cost-of-living differential based on housing cost
6	variations among the State's 31 labor market areas, as determined by the federal
7	Department of Labor using commuting patterns from the 2000 U.S. Census. Under this
8	bill, this regional adjustment would then be applied to the essential programs and services
9	school funding formula, state employee salary negotiations and contracts for services by
10	the Department of Health and Human Services and other state agencies.
