3	§1522. Collaboration with private industry
4 5 6 7	A program of a nonprofit organization, governmental agency or political subdivision or educational institution that receives funds from a bond issue intended to strengthen the economy and industry of the State shall endeavor to work collaboratively with private industry efforts so as not to jeopardize an existing private industry job.
8	SUMMARY
9 0 1	This bill prohibits a program of a nonprofit organization, governmental agency or political subdivision or educational institution that receives state funds from providing goods or services in competition with a private business.
