1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1737, sub-§4**, as amended by PL 2003, c. 20, Pt. OO, §2 and
3 affected by §4 and amended by c. 114, §2, is further amended to read:

4 **4. Directed services.** Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 2, the director
5 shall provide insurance services for private landowners who own lands on January 31,
6 2007 that cross state-owned railroads as defined in Title 23, section 5001, subsection 1
7 and may provide insurance advice or services for family foster homes as defined in Title
8 22, section 8101, subsection 3; specialized children's homes, as defined in Title 22,
9 section 8101, subsection 5; respite care providers as defined in Title 34-B, section 6201,
10 subsection 2-A; the Casco Bay Island Transit District created by Private and Special Law
11 1981, chapter 22; the University of Maine System; the Maine Community College
12 System; the Maine Maritime Academy; and the State's local workforce investment areas
13 designated under the federal Workforce Investment Act of 1998, Public Law 105-220.

14 **SUMMARY**

15 This bill requires that the Director of the Bureau of General Services within the
16 Department of Administrative and Financial Services provide insurance services so that
17 private landowners may purchase insurance for coverage of land crossing state-owned
18 railroads.
